Contestant Rules and Eligibility

Participant must:

1. Be a Kentucky resident.
2. Have reached her 13th birthday by October 31, 2017 and shall not have reached her 16th birthday by October 31, 2017. (Must have been born between October 31, 2001, and October 31, 2004) *A copy of birth certificate must be included with entry form.*
3. Obtain her own sponsor and sponsor fee. (*A sponsor may be a business, an individual, which includes parents, or an organization or group.*) The entry fee must be included with the entry form. No Refunds!
4. The entry fee is \$40 if postmarked on or before July 6. Checks or Money Orders must be made to Franklin County Fair & Horse Show. If registering on July 16, entry fee is \$50 (CASH ONLY).
5. Participate in a personal interview. Participant will be required to wear black shorts, a solid colored top, and white tennis shoes.
6. Appear in an introduction routine that will not be judged. Interview attire should be worn.
7. Appear in casualwear (No Denim) and a floor-length evening dress.
8. Agree to participate in assigned Fair activities, and the 2017 Miss Teen will ride on Fair Board's float in the Christmas Parade in December.
9. Recognize judges' decision as final. Judging will be based on appearance, poise, personality and interview.
10. The Pageant Committee reserves the right to dismiss at any time any contestant who does not show the proper amount of cooperation and courtesy to committee members, consultants and fellow contestants. Horseplay and other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
11. Harassment of fair and pageant officials/volunteers will not be tolerated. Parental interference during rehearsals and the pageant could be cause for participants to be dismissed. Entry fees will not be refunded.
12. Marriage, pregnancy or conduct deemed unbecoming by the Pageant Committee will automatically disqualify the winner.
13. No one (*parents, friends, hairstylists*) will be allowed backstage or in the dressing rooms at any time during the Pageant. Assigned staff will assist the contestants.
14. All questions on entry form are to be answered in complete sentences. A copy of the entry form will be included in the judges' books. Information on the entry form might be read to the audience during the on-stage modeling portions of the pageant.
15. Registration and a mandatory practice session will be held on Sunday, July 16 at the Hancock Pavilion in Lakeview Park at 1:30 pm EDT.
16. Entry forms can be mailed to Miss Teen Pageant, Franklin Co. Fair & Horse Show, P. O. Box 4565, Frankfort KY 40604 if mailed prior to July 6. All other entry forms can be hand delivered to the registration and practice session.
17. People's Choice money must be turned in by the end of practice on July 16. People's Choice Rules can be found elsewhere in the Pageant section of this catalog.
